The Citrus College Esthetician Program provides you with the skills and knowledge to help clients attain healthy skin and an attractive appearance. Administering skin care treatments suited to each individual allows estheticians to help people look and feel their best.

Career opportunities in this field include employment in day spas; full-service hair and skin care salons; in a dermatologist's or plastic surgeon's office as a paramedical esthetician; or as a consultant for a skin care product manufacturer. Subjects covered in

Students completing the program with a grade of "C" or better, will receive a certificate of achievement and are eligible to take the California State Board of Barbering and Cosmetology Licensing Examination.

- Assessment test required for associate degree, certificate of achievement and transfer students.
- Financial aid is available to qualified students. Complete and submit FAFSA to determine your eligibility.
- Non-Transferable
Hours from other schools are not accepted
- Passing State Board examination required to become a licensed esthetician

New students enrolled in five or more units and planning to earn an associate degree, a certificate of achievement, or a skill award must take an English and math skills assessment. In addition, new students who plan to enroll in English, mathematics or reading classes must participate in the skills assessment process.

Associate Degree

For an associate degree, a student must complete 60 degree applicable units of work and fulfill specific general education requirements, including electives and physical education. A cumulative grade-point average of 2.0 ("C") or above is required.
