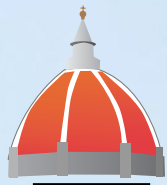

Earn 6 units of CSU/UC transferable credit that meets general education requirements:

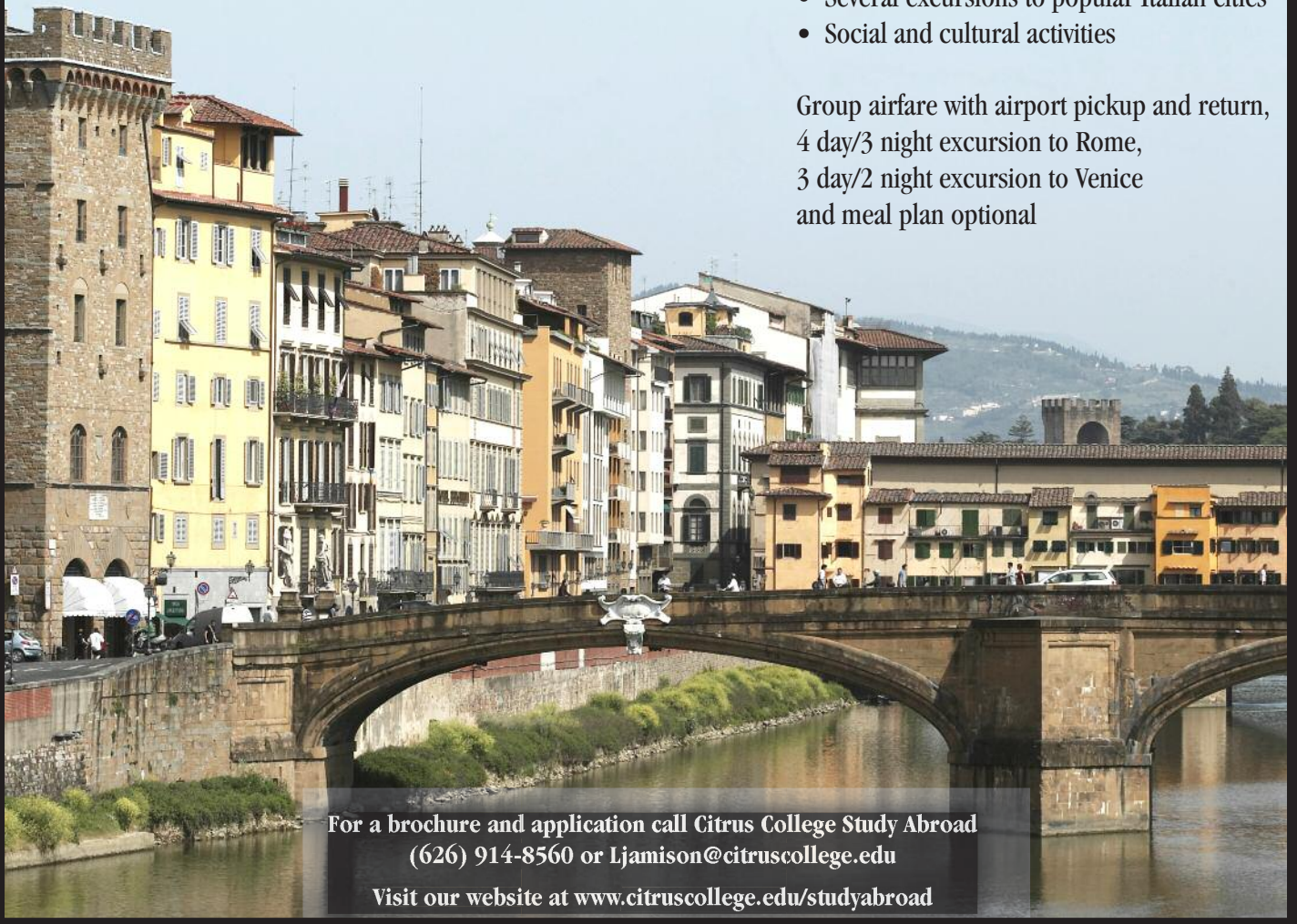
